Duration	4 days	4 to 6 days
Time Away from Practice	Only 2 weekdays	2 to 6 weekdays
Cost	\$7500	Up to \$12000
Faculty to Student Ratio	3 to 1	Often students are frustrated at not having the attention they need.
Workstations per Participant	Each participant has his/her own workstation	At many courses participants do not enjoy their own workstation, which is essential to gaining confidence in manipulating the data for accurate reading.
Workstation Types	Siemens Leonardo, TeraRecon, Vital Images	Many courses do not offer a wide array of workstation options.
Atmosphere	Collegial and Casual	Some courses do not strive, as we do, to make your stay relaxed and enjoyable.
Live Cases	Only course to offer 50 live cases in one weekend	Adequate live case volume is necessary to achieving certification and most courses cannot guarantee adequate numbers in short periods of time.
Mentored Library	Exquisite, complete and well catalogued with complete expert reads. Many cath correlations	Many case libraries are full of normals with a poor selection of pathology. Often insufficient cath correlation is provided.
Level I Pre-Requisite	Included in level II course	Often hidden fee for additional pre-requisite level I training
CME	20 hours included. Up to 40 hours possible with the Cardiac CT Angiography CME Program	Many courses may not provide adequate CME hours to gain level II certification.
Certification Certificates	Presented before participants leave Cincinnati.	Often participants experience inconvenient delays in receiving certification materials
Reading Style	Focus on a proven, organized, systematic approach	Courses with disorganized reading styles are unacceptable.
Credibility	Authors of well respected Cardiac CT Angiography Manual	Many course faculty lack credibility to establish themselves as effective instructors.
